










Girl Scouts find themselves and change the world—one adventure at a time.

(This event is designed for new girls who have not joined Girl Scouts. Current Girl Scout members may only attend if they are bringing a friend who is interested in joining.)


COST: This event is **FREE!** The cost of membership is \$25/year. Financial assistance is available for membership, council activities, and uniforms.
